### \_\_\_\_ **Math: Nets and Numbers**

Provides teachers in grades K-12 with fun interactive lesson plans that incorporate hockey and Bruins themes into state math curriculum guidelines. The Bruins worked in conjunction with MTA to create the curriculum materials for the program. Students who participate in the program receive one free ticket, with the purchase of one adult ticket, to a pre-selected Boston Bruins Home Game. Program will run December 1<sup>st</sup> through April and materials will be available through the MTA website

### \_\_\_\_ **Savings: Savings Makes “Cents”**

The program focuses on teaching students in grades K-5 the fundamentals of money management. A representative from the State Treasurer’s office visits classrooms throughout Massachusetts to teach children basic skills such as how to open a savings account, basic budgeting, and the origin of money. As a part of the Saving Makes “Cents” program, educators are provided with an educational curriculum that coincides with state guidelines. Savings Makes “Cents” will launch in January and run through April.

### \_\_\_\_ **Geography: Icing the Globe**

The Bruins have worked to develop curriculum materials that incorporate geographical information about player’s home countries, as well as the different NHL teams throughout North America. Teachers will be able to incorporate the Bruins themed activities into state mandated geography curriculum for 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> graders. The Icing the Globe program will begin October 24<sup>th</sup> and run through April.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Music: Hit a High Note**

This year the Bruins are teaming up with the MTA and WCRB to help promote the Music Matters Program by introducing Hit a High Note. The Bruins will work with WCRB to help introduce students to a variety of musical instruments, along side members of the Newton-based New Philharmonic Orchestra. The Hit a High Note Program will begin January 12<sup>th</sup> and run through April.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Fitness/Health – Chara’s Challenge**

The Bruins and the MTA have teamed up to present Chara’s Challenge, a fitness and wellness program for children in grades K-8 throughout Massachusetts. Chara’s Challenge is designed to help physical education and health educators develop fitness and dietary goals that are in-line with the state curriculum guidelines. Participating students receive a Bruins Score Card that lays out activities and goals, as well as, helps students to track their individual growth and improvement during the program. Students who participate in the program received one free ticket, with the purchase of one adult ticket, to a pre-selected Boston Bruins Home Game. The Chara’s Challenge program will begin in January and run through April.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Environmental – B’s Go Green**

The B’s Go Green program serves to teach children the importance of learning to live an environmentally friendly lifestyle at an early age. The Bruins have created fun easy ways for students in grades three through five to become more environmentally friendly. The program not only teaches students new ways to reduce their effects on our environment, but also the consequences of our current lifestyles on the environment.
